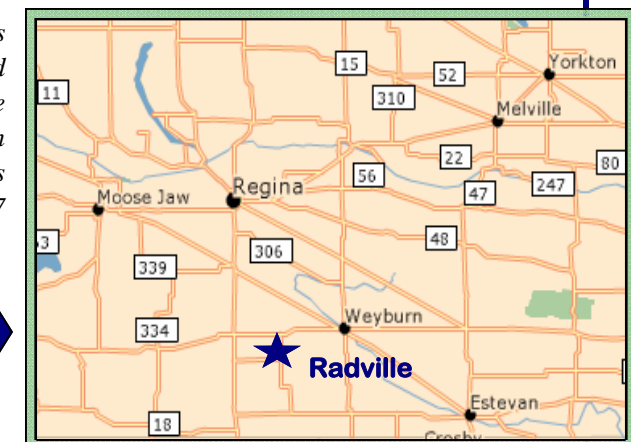

Location

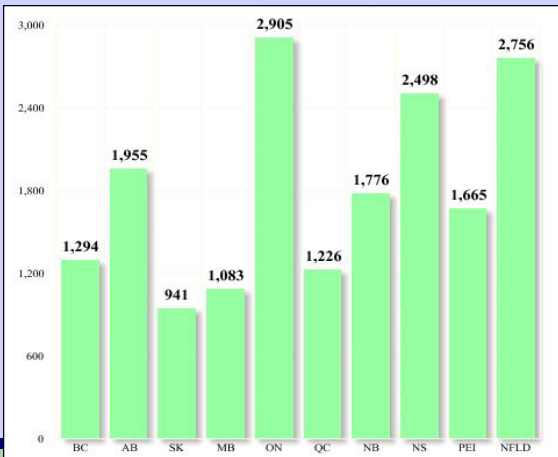
Radville is situated on the intersection of highways #28 & #377

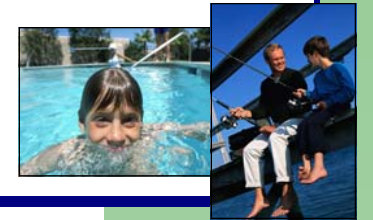
